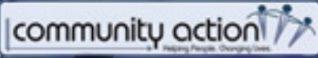

Project Dawn Lunch and Learn

Project DAWN is a network of Ohio-based drug overdose education and naloxone distribution programs. Project DAWN programs provide take-home naloxone kits to the public free of charge.



Participants receive training on:

- Identifying risk factors for opioid overdose.
- Recognizing an overdose.
- Calling emergency medical services.
- Giving intranasal naloxone.
- Monitoring the person until help arrives.
