SNAP Replacement Benefits - Power Outage/Food Loss

If you are a SNAP recipient and your household has experienced a misfortune (such as a fire or flood, or a power outage lasting more than four hours) that results in a loss of food, you may be eligible for SNAP replacement benefits.

Who is eligible for replacement benefits?

To be eligible, an individual or household must have received SNAP food assistance benefits during the month in which the disaster occurred.



POWER OUTAGES

How are these benefits provided?

Replacement SNAP benefits are added to recipients' Ohio Direction Cards. To receive the benefits, households must complete the **JFS 07222 Statement Requesting Replacement of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Benefits** within 10 days of the loss.

✓ **MATERIALS ACCEPTED:**

PAINT: Oil based paint & paint products - 5 gallon container or smaller. Aerosols acceptable. Includes adhesives/roof tar/driveway sealers. No latex paints will be accepted.

HOUSEHOLD CLEANERS: Acid and caustic products.

BATTERIES: All household batteries. Lead acid automotive batteries.

AUTOMOTIVE FLUIDS: Motor oil, up to 5 gallon containers - prefer 1 gallon containers, antifreeze, brake fluid, grease, fuels.

PESTICIDES: Liquids, solids and aerosols in homeowner sizes.

MERCURY: Thermometers, thermostats, fluorescent bulbs & tubes, and elemental mercury.

⊗ **UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS:**

Explosives, ammunition, gas cylinders, radioactive wastes, pharmaceuticals or large quantities of unknown materials. No tires accepted.
